KHPT eyes RM155 mil revenue from Proton's supply contract

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KUALA LUMPUR (June 18): Automotive parts manufacturer KHPT Holdings Bhd (KL:KHB) expects to generate RM155 million in revenue from a new contract awarded by Perusahaan Otomobil Nasional Sdn Bhd (Proton) to supply structural components for an upcoming model.

The contract, awarded to its wholly owned unit Automev Global Sdn Bhd (AGSB), is dependent on projected orders

from Proton and will remain valid throughout the model's lifecycle, said KHPT in a statement on Thursday.

Under the agreement, AGBS will manufacture and supply selected structural components to support Proton's production needs, with output to be carried out at KHPT's existing facility in Telok Panglima Garang, Selangor.

KHPT group managing director Datin Eloise See said the contract highlights the group's continued role in the domestic automotive supply chain and its longstanding relationship with Proton.

"This (contract) reflects our technical capabilities, manufacturing discipline and commitment to consistently meeting customer requirements. We remain focused on operational execution, quality, and supporting the long-term development of Malaysia's automotive supply chain," she said.
